What is EDI? Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) is the computer-to-computer exchange of routine shipment data between trucking agents and their forwarder/3PL customers in standard data formats.

How Crown EDI Works:

- 1 Electronic order alerts are sent to trucking company's computerized dispatch.
- 2 Electronic alert acceptance are sent to shipper's computer.
- 3 On hand, out for delivery, and POD delivery statuses are sent to shipper.
- 4 Recovered and transferred statuses on pickups are sent to shipper.
- 5 Scanned images are sent directly into shipper's computer system.
- 6 Electronic invoices are sent directly into shipper's computer system.

Automated Orders

Shipment orders are sent from shippers to trucking agent's computer system electronically and shipment statuses/PODs are sent back to shippers as updates occur with little or no human intervention.

Real-time Updates

As shipment statuses such as recovered/transferred on pick-ups and out-for-delivery/POD on deliveries are updated in Crown, the statuses are electronically sent to shipper's computer system in near real-time.

Electronic Receipts

Eliminate or reduce the manual entry of new shipment alerts into your Crown system with electronic receipt of orders.

Less Back-and-Forth

Eliminate or reduce unnecessary phone, fax and email communication between you and your forwarder/3PL customers.
